III. Update from Director of GOALS Academy, Dr. Schroeder:

A. School Calendar for 2019-2020

Dr. Schroeder asked the School Site Council Committee to approve the calendar with the adjustment of the Open house be changed to a Thursday night instead of a Friday. Many families left on a 3-day weekend, so they were missing the Open house.

B. Recruitment and Enrollment Process

Dr. Schroeder will be adjusting the process during the drawing. We used to start to TK/K drawing through 6th. We will be changing to a reversed process. It will start with 6th grade – TK/K. Sibling rules with the priority the older scholar must still be enrolled to be considered a current sibling. We do not intend to go to 32. Our budget is based on 240. The 32 allowance would allow for an adjustment to hit that number.

C. SARC

Dr. Schroeder, School Accountability Report Card for 2018-2019, The data is pulled from the 2017-2018 school year. She focused on the CAASPP scores portion of the report. She shared the comparison with the state scores and our local area. There is room for growth. It is a document of the Statistics of our school in all areas. This document is due to be turned in California Department of Education in February, 2019.

D. CASSPP Dashboard

Dr. Schroeder shared that the CASSPP is the California standard test for 3rd-6th grade. She pointed out the test is presented in computer form and she shared the challenges with the new format. The big change from the CST is the level of analysis that is required. The test is more conceptual. Being able to explain the math problem and its solution is the focus on

how the scholars need to tackle the problems. She shared her analysis compared to the AESD. We came in 4th in comparison to the 23 schools in the area. She shared the teachers are aware of the issues and are addressing the background to do well. The classrooms will be doing interim test assessments that help them understand the concept of this style of testing. She shared that parents will be encouraged to visit the CASSPP Dashboard. She shared the data and the different categories that the dashboard breaks down the information.

E. Behavior Plan Adjustments

Dr. Schroeder shared the current plan and presented a possible adjustment to allow for the victim rights in the resolution process. She shared a possible addition to the current plan that focuses on the step needed to be implemented to give a voice to the victim of the behavioral incidences. The follow up process would be adjusted to assure, the one being harmed, would be more There would be an improved communication protocol to inform the parent of the incident and the consequences in a timely manner. The after-school program will be informed and trained on this change. Shalena Harris suggests that a new parent orientation for how our school approaches behavioral plans. She suggests a video presentation that all new parents and scholars would need to be viewed prior to their first day on instruction. She also suggested that classes should be provided to parents struggling with parenting strategies. Yvette LaValle will research a Love and Logic Training. A suggestion box was recommended as a way for scholars to share concerns on campus. Dr. Schroeder will be present proposed revised Behavior Plan.
